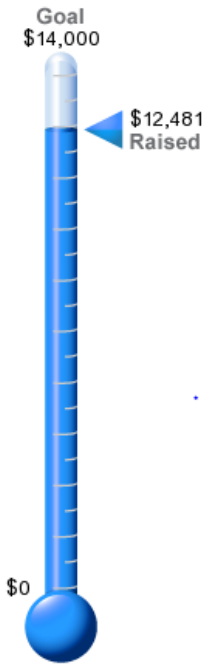

to walk closer in Your way.

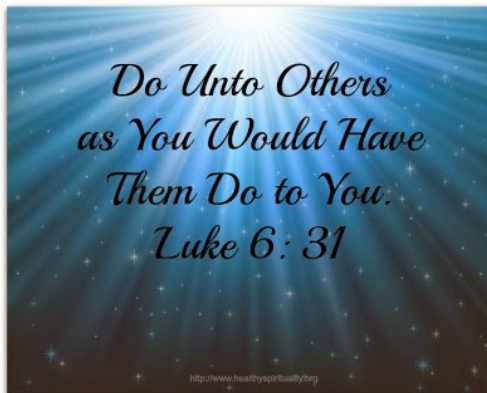
But Lord, I am well aware,
